

Molino dei Lessi,
Due Rubini 2006
IGT Vigneti delle Dolomiti
17 Drink 2011-18

This wine comes from the commune of Sorni at an altitude of 350 m. The organically tended 1 ha vineyard is planted with Lagrein and Cabernet Sauvignon on calcareous soils and completely surrounded by forest.

The 2006 vintage was the first year this particular blend of 80% Cabernet Sauvignon and 20% Lagrein was made.

Very deep ruby. Crushed red fruits and blueberry.

Hint of blackcurrant leaves.

High-tuned acidity carries a cherry and blueberry palate.

Grainy tannin.

Quite unbelievable but the 2006 is the current release.

Very young and fresh! (WS) 13%
